4 polskor från Skinnskatteberg/ Norberg efter skogvaktare Johan Wilhelm Johansson, upptecknade av Karl Peter Leffler (1865-1922)

Johan Wilhelm Johansson föddes den 4 maj 1870 på Bergfors övra i Skinnskatteberg. Han far var skogvaktaren Anders Johan Johansson, född i Skinnskatteberg och hans mor Johanna Westerberg, född i Norberg. År 1877 flyttade familjen, som då bestod av föräldrarna och tre barn, till Baggbyn i samma socken. År 1895 flyttade familjen till Lövsta i Almunge, Uppland. I kyrkböckerna uppges han nu vara kronojägare. År 1896 upptecknade K.P. Leffler en hel del låtar efter J.W. Johansson, bland annat nedanstående 4 polskor som Johansson uppgav härstammade från sin hembygd.
